Joint Meeting

Mayor Russ Meyer, Commissioners John Collier, Andy Williams, and Chris Moore attended a quarterly joint meeting between the City of Nicholasville, City of Wilmore, and the Jessamine County Fiscal Court. The meeting was held at the Wilmore Community Center, Wilmore, KY on April 9, 2007 at 6:00 p.m.

Wilmore Mayor Harold Rainwater hosted the joint meeting and the items were discussed:

- ❖ Dan Bowling, Animal Hospital of Nicholasville discussed a stray cat program, Trap, Neuter, and Release (TNR). Mr. Bowling reported that success of this type of program has worked in other communities and educating the community is extremely important. The City of Nicholasville will work with the Animal Hospital of Nicholasville to get messages on utility bills in the future.
- ❖ Comprehensive Plan – Joint Effort. The countywide comprehensive plan was discussed and there was not any objection to moving forward on creating this joint plan.
- ❖ Limbs and Brush – Commissioner Andy Williams reported to the group on what steps the City of Nicholasville has taken to help the citizens of Nicholasville dispose of brush/limbs. The program details are not completely worked out.
- ❖ Planning Commission and Board of Adjustments Salaries – The City of Wilmore and the Jessamine County Fiscal Court agreed to bring up for vote at a scheduled meeting to increase salaries of the Jessamine County – City of Wilmore Joint Planning Commission and Board of Adjustment members.
- ❖ Tourism Tax – It was discussed with the group on implementing a county-wide motel tax. There was some objection to the tax on a county-wide basis.

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
