

November 1, 2007
Special Meeting

The Board of Commission of the City of Nicholasville convened in special session on Thursday, November 1, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Russ Meyer presided and the following commissioners were present: Mr. Danny Shearer, Mr. John Collier, Mr. Andy Williams and Mr. Chris Moore. City Attorney, William M. Arvin was present.

At this time a hearing was called to order to consider revoking the business license of Unified Doers Management Group, LLC. There was no representative from Unified Doers Management Group, LLC present. The charges were read as follows:

Comes, Russ Meyer, Mayor of the City of Nicholasville, and submits to the City Clerk of the City of Nicholasville, the following Charge against Unified Doers Management Group, LLC:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 21.30 of the Nicholasville Code of Ordinances, the City of Nicholasville does hereby charge Unified Doers Management Group, LLC, of misconduct by its employees and/or agents.
2. The employees and/or agents of Unified have been operating in a disorderly manner so as to cause a disturbance of the good order of the community of Nicholasville.
3. On or about October 11, 2007, Unified Doers Management Group, LLC by and through its employee and/or agent, Raquel Perkins of 1030 Shiver Street, Atlanta, Georgia, caused a disturbance to the good order of the community of Nicholasville as evidenced by criminal charges by the City of Nicholasville Police Department against her for the following:
 - a. Criminal Littering
 - b. Terrorist Threatening

A copy of the police report is attached hereto for reference.

4. The City of Nicholasville has further received numerous Complaints by various Citizens of the City of Nicholasville who indicate uneasiness and alarm over the activities of the employees and/or agents of Unified Doers Management Group, LLC, which said calls give rise to this Charge for disturbance of the good order of the community of the City of Nicholasville.
5. It is the recommendation of the Mayor of the City of Nicholasville, that upon consideration by the City of Nicholasville Board of Commissioners, that, in the event it is found that the employees and/or agents of Unified Doers Management Group, LLC, are guilty of causing a disturbance to the good order of the community of the City of Nicholasville, that the Board of Commissions permanently revoke the business license of Unified Doers Management Group, LLC.

Charged this the 25th day of October 2007. Signed Russ Meyer, Mayor.

After testimony from the Chief of Police, Officer Joshua Filson, and Officer Gab Kinderknecht and comments from the commission the hearing was declared closed at 6:20 p.m.
