

The Jessamine County Fiscal Court hosted a joint meeting between the Jessamine County Fiscal Court, City of Nicholasville, and City of Wilmore on February 22, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at the EMS – West in Wilmore, KY for the following agenda:

1. Proposed Smoke Free Ordinance
2. Proposed Social Host Ordinance
3. Commonwealth Commitment College and Career Ready

Mayor Russ Meyer, Commissioners Blackford, Collier, Sutherland and Williams were present.

Jessamine County Judge-Executive Neal Cassity called the meeting to order. The proposed Smoke Free Ordinance was discussed. Each government will consider the ordinance for passage individually. The City of Nicholasville will discuss the ordinance at the March 7, 2011 Workshop. Major John Branscum of the Nicholasville Police Department gave a brief overview of the Social Host Ordinance and answered questions from the elected officials. The City of Nicholasville will have first reading of the ordinance at the February 28, 2011 regular meeting. Superintendent Lu Young shared “The Commonwealth Commitment, College and Career Ready” and encouraged each government to pass a resolution pledging their support to the Jessamine County Schools and Jessamine County students and their families as they increase the rate of college and career readiness of the graduates in our school district from 42% to 71% in 2015. The City of Nicholasville will have the resolution on the February 28, 2011 agenda.
