Joint Meeting – City of Nicholasville, Jessamine County Fiscal Court, and City of Wilmore

The Jessamine County Fiscal Court hosted a joint meeting between the Jessamine County Fiscal Court, City of Nicholasville, and City of Wilmore on January 15, 2008 at the Jessamine County Courthouse at 5:00 p.m.

Jessamine County Judge-Executive Neal Cassity called the meeting to order and the following county magistrates were present: Terry Meckstroth, Duane McCuddy, Tim Vaughn, John Nickell, and George Dean. Also present was Brian Goettl, County Attorney. Mayor Russ Meyer and the following city commissioners were present: John Collier, Danny Shearer, Andy Williams and Chris Moore. Wilmore Mayor Harold Rainwater and the following city council members were present: Jeff Baier, Jim Brumfield, and Kim Dyer.

Greg Bohnett gave an update on the Joint Comprehensive Plan. The twenty-member committee is looking over consultants to update the plan and should have a decision within the next two to three weeks.

There was discussion on the intersection of Hwy 29 and Jessamine Station. The intersection poses a safety concern. Commissioner Danny Shearer will contact the state and others to see about getting the pole moved.

A committee was formed to talk about parking in the downtown. The committee will meet after the February 12, 2008 Downtown Master Plan Open House that will be held from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Jessamine County Chamber of Commerce.

Lu Young, Jessamine County School Superintendent introduced Assistant Chief of Police, John Branscum and the four School Resource Officers. Assistant Chief of Police Branscum gave an update on the SRO program.
