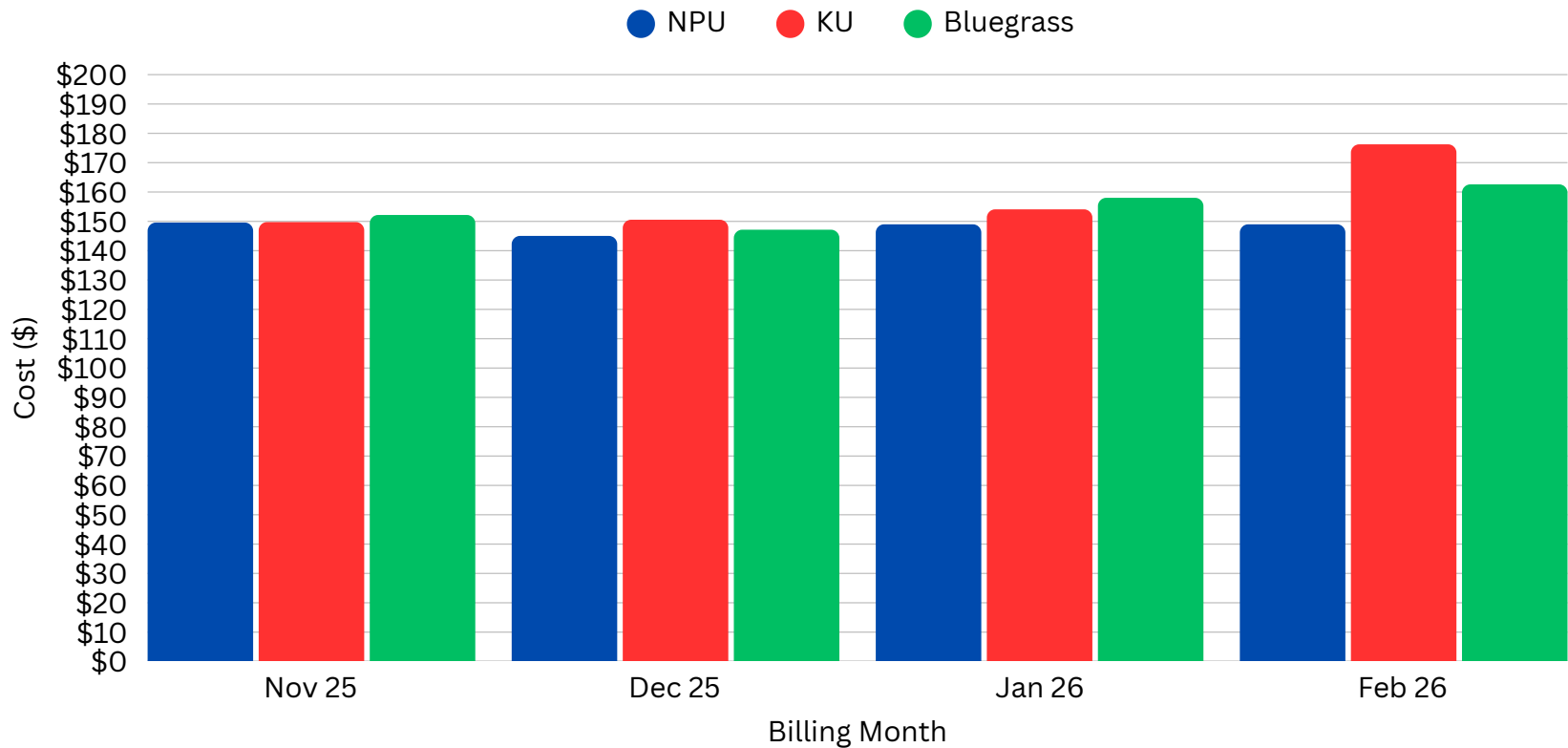




COMPARE OUR RATES

Residential Electric Bill Comparison

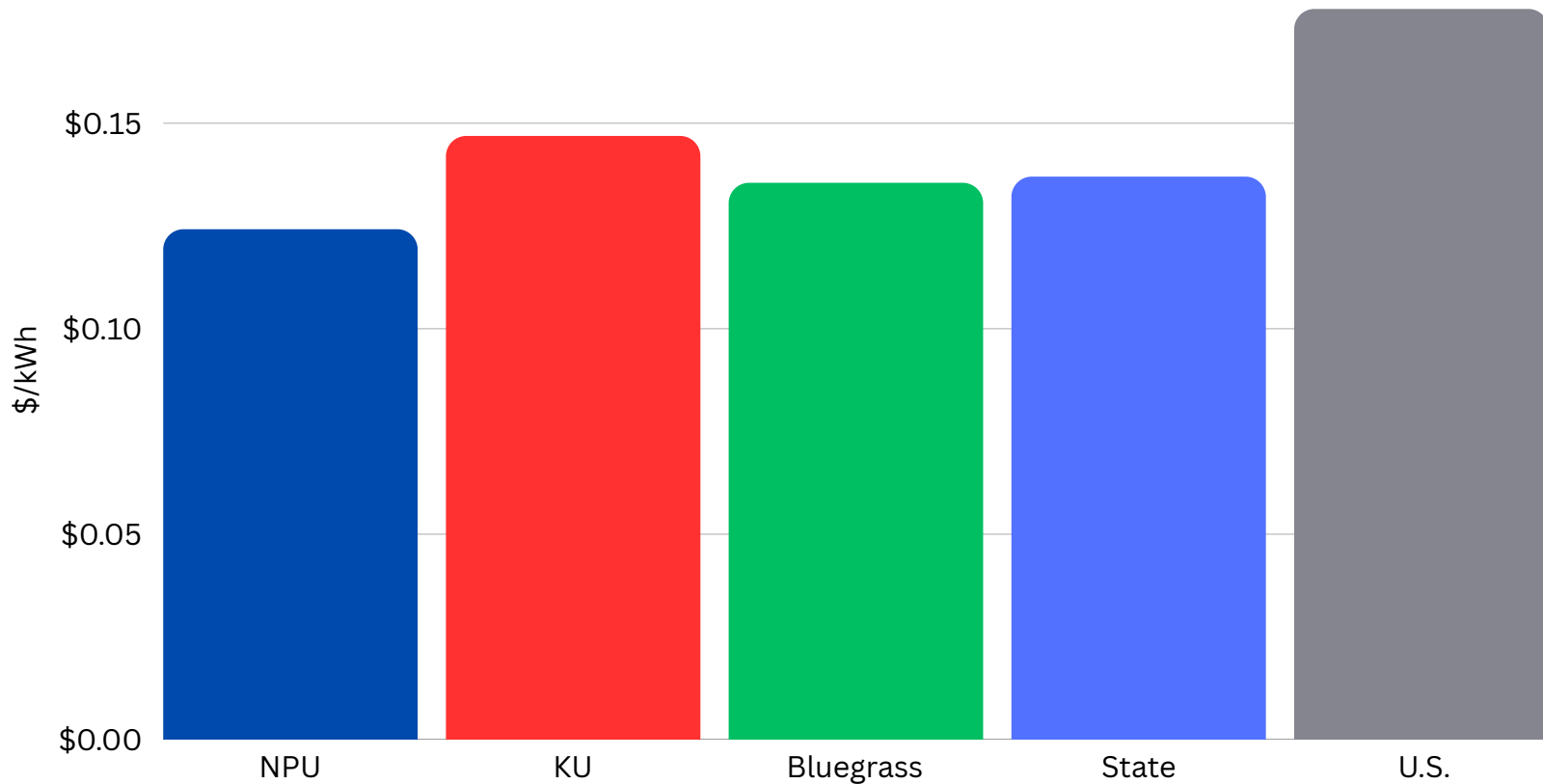


**Bill Comparison based on February 2026 bill at 1,200 kWh's usage*

On average, NPU's bills averaged about 14% cheaper than other providers within the county. NPU's cost per kWh is about 10% lower than the state average and 43% lower than the U.S. average.

Billing Reminders

- Most bills are posted and available to view on your customer portal around the 18th of each month. If you have not seen your bill around this time please call our office. NPU cannot guarantee that mailed bills will arrive on time.
- All NPU bills are due by the 10th of each month, if payment is not received or only a partial payment is received by this time, a 10% penalty is assessed to the remaining balance.
- Any past due amount not paid by midnight on the 21st of each month is subject to disconnection and a \$25 reconnect fee.
- Customers receiving only sewer services from NPU in the northern portion of the County, if you have not seen your bill by the end of the month, please reach out to us; these bills are dependent on reads from Jessamine County Water District #1 that do not come in until later in the month.
